Everyone interested is warmly invited to attend.

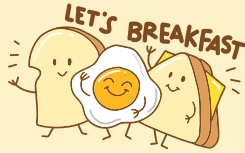

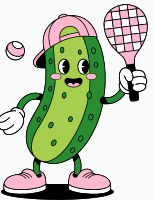

Our Kenyan Kids

Helping young Kenyans - one child at a time



NEWS from Our Kenyan Kids

Members of the Board of Our Kenyan Kids are planning to travel to Kenya in January 2027. We are looking forward to visiting our Kenyan partners in person and wanted to share an update on this important work.

Water Tanks and Food

In January 2026, Nelson in Embu County reported a 40-year drought that had caused crop failures and serious water shortages. With the support of donors, we provided emergency food and refilled **59 water tanks** purchased between 2023 and 2025.

By April, conditions had improved, allowing families to plant and harvest crops that are expected to help sustain them through the end of the year.



Moving Forward

Our goal is to help families with water tanks become more self-sufficient. We are now launching **Phase 2 of the project: chicken farming.**

Each participating family will receive **15 chickens, feed and medication**, along with training in chicken care, disease prevention, egg handling and marketing. Families will build their own coops and fencing.

The chickens will provide eggs for food, income from selling eggs, and manure for family gardens.

The cost is **\$175 per family**, and our goal is to support **62 families—nearly 300 people**. As with the water tank project, sponsors of the chicken project will receive photos of the family they are helping.
