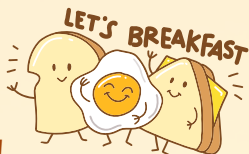

This is a biblical theological study of the whole book Colossians, all 4 chapters, lasting 6 weeks, with Donald.



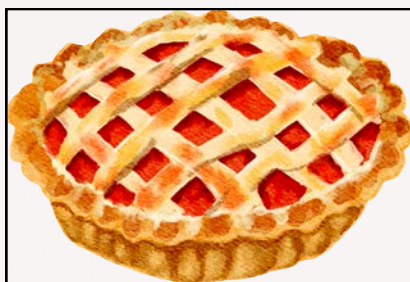

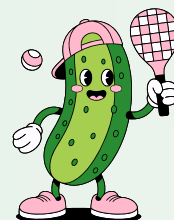
The prices are **\$15.00 for a large pie and \$7.00 for a small pie.**
