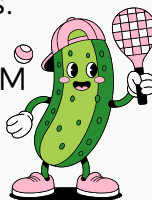

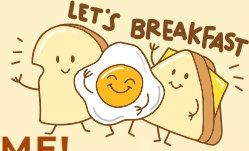

AN IMPORTANT UPDATE FROM PAUL BULLOCK

A path moving forward: Forming the Profile & Search Team

As you heard from Laura last Sunday, Pastor Kim will not be returning to WSUC when she completes her three-year appointment as Moderator, we would like to explain our path forward.

What is good about the United Church is that they allow each church, or as they call it, each Community of Faith, to manage their own affairs. At the regional level, it's called the Eastern Ontario Outaouais Regional Council (EOORC). They govern by rules – many rules, and we are required to follow these rules in order to hire a minister. Our advisor is Victoria Andrews, who is the Regional Minister for Pastoral Relations.

We have been asked to form a **Profile and Search Team**. This team will do the following:

- Survey the congregation regarding what characteristics are important in a minister.
- Create a full-time ministry job description based on the surveyed information.
- Write a profile that describes our church.
- Present *job description* and *Church's profile* to the board and congregation for approval.
- Obtain approval from Victoria Andrews.
- Post this information on a United Church HUB so that ministers across the country can examine them and apply for the position.

Victoria suggested that we should have 4-7 members on the team. It should be a short-term commitment that will complete its work before the end of October.
