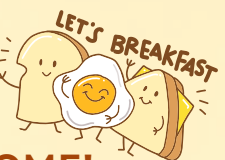

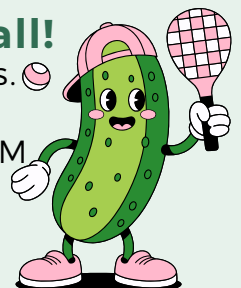

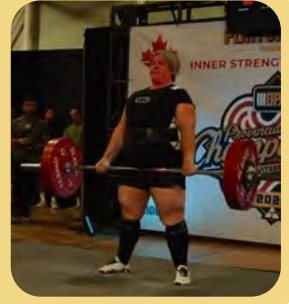

OUR KENYAN KIDS – UPDATE ON CHICKEN FARMING PROJECT



Last August, we shared news that we were beginning a new chicken farming project in Kenya. Our goal was to help **62 families** (almost 300 people), who previously received water tanks, to become more self-sufficient. Chickens would provide eggs for consumption and for sale, plus chicken manure would fertilize kitchen gardens. Each participating family could receive **15 chickens, feed and medication**, along with **training in chicken care, disease prevention, egg handling and marketing**. Beneficiaries are responsible for constructing their own poultry houses. Nelson, "our man on the ground" has stressed that "each beneficiary is using the resources available to construct their chicken house." He has shared photos of the chicken houses, and we are impressed by the diversity of the homes.



Thank you to everyone who has reached out to us, following news of the chicken farming endeavor. All sponsors of the chicken project will receive photos of the family they are helping. Please reach out to us if you/your family/friends wish to help. The **total cost** to support each Kenyan family is **\$175, BUT every donation**, no matter the amount, **makes a big difference. Your kindness will change lives.**

The Art of Conversation

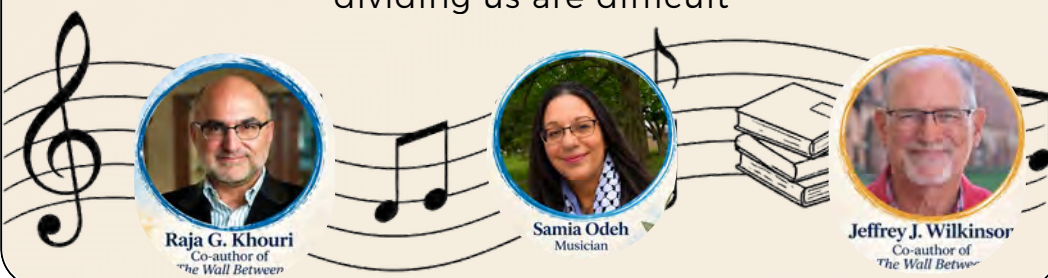
